

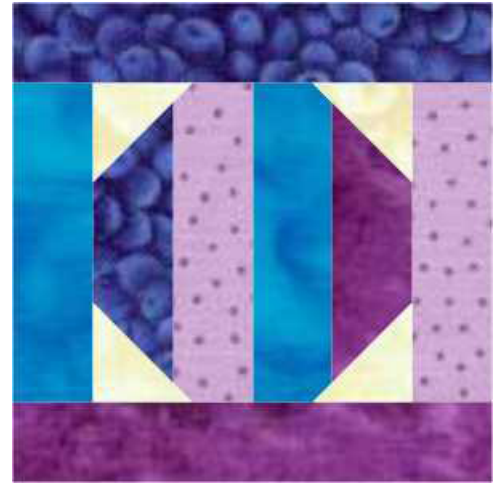

This is an easy block to piece. You can choose to use four different strips or eight. Pick the medium to medium dark shades in the group.

If using four strips cut:

Fabric #1: Two 8 1/2"

Fabric #2: Two 8 1/2"

Fabric #3: One 8 1/2" and one 12 1/2"

Fabric #4: One 8 1/2" and one 12 1/2"

If using eight strips cut:

One 8 1/2" from fabrics #1 - #6

One 12 1/2" from fabrics #7 and #8

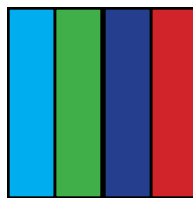
From the light background fabric cut:

Four 3" x 3"

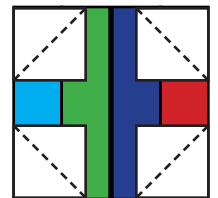
Draw a diagonal line on the backs of the squares\*

**CONSTRUCTION**

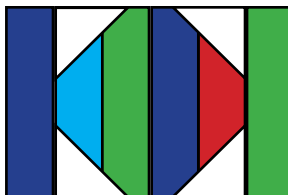
1. Sew the 8 1/2" x 2 1/2" fabrics #1 - #4 long sides together. Press in one direction.



2. Line the 3" background squares on each corner, right sides together. Sew along drawn line and trim to 1/4" from stitching. Press to triangles.\*



3. Sew the 8 1/2" x 2 1/2" fabrics #1 and #2 (or #5 and #6) to each side. Press to outside.



\*Instead of drawing the lines, considering using my new tool "Cutting Corners".

Now wasn't that EASY!

4. Sew the 12 1/2" x 2 1/2" fabric #3 and #4 (or #7 and #8) to the top and bottom. Press to outside.
